This mapping platform helps divide a large mapping project into smaller grids that can be completed rapidly and collaboratively, with many people contributing to a collective project goal.


The tool shows what needs to be mapped, which areas need to be reviewed and validated for quality assurance and which areas are completed.

We work together to provide map data that revolutionizes disaster management, reduces risks, and contributes to the achievement of the Sustainable Development Goals.




Best Contribution Methods

Be the change you want to see in the world

Keep it Small & Simple

- Aim for quality over quantity
- Map simple features (e.g., points only)
- Even if you are comfortable with more complex features, consider keeping it simple until you get to know the OSM ways of working
- Use foolproof tools



Make good-quality edits



Be a part of the community






Follow the community mapping conventions



Map what you know

- Use local knowledge (by editing in your neighborhood, vacation area, hometown, etc.)
- Do not map based on proprietary sources
- Map the features you know



Changeset descriptions and labels

 Provide a concise and adequate description for your edit out of courtesy for your fellow mappers, to avoid misunderstandings, and get mistakes fixed quickly.



Changeset comments

 Respond to comments to thank users for their feedback or corrections, and fix any remaining mistakes they pointed out. This shows that you care about the quality of the map. Do not argue.
