

# HOW WOULD YOU DESCRIBE A PATH?

PATH: <u>highway</u>=path indicates a generic path that is used by pedestrians, small vehicles like bicycles, for animal riding or livestock. A <u>highway</u>=path is not for use by four-wheeled (two-track) vehicles.

# HOW WOULD YOU DESCRIBE AN ALLEY?

ALLEY: <u>highway=service</u>


An alley is a narrow service road or highway that's usually located between properties and provides access to back gardens, fire exits, storage areas, and rear entrances. Alleys are often found in urban areas and can run between the rear sides of buildings

# HOW WOULD YOU DESCRIBE A LIVING STREET?


LIVING STREET: These roads are still available for use by motor vehicles; however, their design aims to reduce both the speed and dominance of motorized transport.










