


Review Process: Who does what when?

The person who translated the last article in a blog presses this button to call all editors of the respective language for review.




Then

The first reviewer arrives and then the first corrector comes and presses before making a correction the button: Start Personal Review

Then

The reviewer starts his review

When the reviewer finished the correction, he/she ****writes a small comment**** which can be helpful for other reviewer (compare the comments in other languages in already completed editions) into the box "Please write your Review here" and then

press the "REVIEW" button.

Then

Other reviewers (sometimes up to five in some languages) then correct it. We agreed that we want to have at least two reviews. The find in the blue icon is the number of reviews.
